Short Synopsis

New Zealand 1899. James, devastated by the loss of his wife, is lured into a lifestyle of depravity by a group of societal fringe-dwellers. An intriguing gothic thriller.

Long Synopsis

James lies at the graveside of his wife Helen. He recalls an invite from his friend Archie to attend a party. James arrives by carriage to a grand house and welcomed by his old friend Archie who ushers him in to meet the host of the party Callum, and James draws the attention of a beautiful lady Isabelle.

Callum insists that James should stay the night and even offers some fine clothes to wear. James enjoys the party but is reminded of some curious stories about the house and its guests. He is surprised and seduced by Isabelle whilst alone in the wine store. James manages to recover his composure but is distraught by the renewed party debauchery and a strange warning from the maid. Archie persuades James to rest a while.

James mourns for Helen and contemplates his own death. James is alarmed to hear the maid screaming as she is pursued by Callum across the lawn. On returning to the party, James discovers it is really a coven of vampires. He is seduced and forgetting his grief momentarily gives himself to Isabelle. James realises too late that this new vampire life has cursed him to be separated from his beloved Helen forever.

Director's Notes: David Gunson

The tales of Victorian horror and suspense have been a rich source of our mythology. The Edgar Allen Poe stories, Frankenstein, Jack the Ripper and Jekyll and Hyde have resonated with themes of love and destruction. Add to the mix the ghoulish nature of the nosferatu or vampire and you have a world of high stakes, deception, death and sex. These days true love is so often seen as a transient and illusive thing but in the Victorian age it was seen as a powerful bond that defeated even death so that love, no matter how fleeting for mortals could be renewed in the afterlife.

In *Auld Lang Syne*, James is in despair at the death of his wife, but is enchanted by the hosts of a party and the allure of Isabelle, a beautiful seductress. James ignores his better nature and offers himself to the vampires -forfeiting his chance to rest in peace with his wife, and thus condemned to walk for forever in the half-light between the living and the dead. The story takes place when in an age when ethics and duty were paramount, when the rules of society dictated behaviour; these rules once discarded lead to unwished for desires. Over the course of this tale these feelings consume a man who strays down the wrong path.

Director's Bio

David Gunson was studying Graphic Design when the filmmaking bug bit him and he soon discovered the joy of creating new worlds for the camera. David has since directed several 'Film Noir' Super-8 epics, music videos for Darcy Clay (*Jesus I was evil*) and Hayley Westenra and made two 16mm films dealing with the supernatural and the historical, -two of his favourite subjects, which have naturally come together for his first N.Z.F.C. film *Auld Lang Syne*. David's film heroes are Stanley Kubrick, Len Lye, David Lean and the Coen Brothers.

It has sold to Canal + (France, Belgium & Poland) and Universal (Italy). Karl's earlier short film **A NEW WAY HOME** (writer/director: Michael Duignan) enjoyed selection at the Edinburgh and Melbourne International Film Festivals.

Karl also works as an Executive Producer, overseeing the development and production for a slate of six short films for the NZ Film Commission. These films include **TAMA TU** (writ/dir: Taika Waititi – Sundance 2005, Berlin 2005 – Special Jury Prize Panorama Section) **TRUANT** (dir: Michael Duignan, New York Film Festival 2005) and **THE LITTLE THINGS** (writ/dir: Reina Webster – Special Jury Prize Berlin Kinderfest 2005).

Karl also produces television - his comedy pilot **TALENT**, funded by TVNZ and NZ On Air, screened in August 2005.

He also has a number of feature films in development, some of them with the NZ Film Commission.

Karl's efforts and talents have already been recognized by the NZ Film Industry - he is the only producer to have won the SPADA Young Filmmaker of the Year.
