# **Director's Bio**



Jochen FitzHerbert was born in Auckland New Zealand but moved to the Philippines with his family for eighteen years before moving back to New Zealand in 1997. He completed a Masters in Creative and Performing Arts in 2002 at The University of Auckland. Majoring in directing and writing, Jochen now splits his time between working in post-production and writing.

His student film, *After Dark*, played in numerous festivals around New Zealand as well as winning the Kinder Kino competition at the Corto Imola Film Festival in Italy. In 2003, Jochen wrote *Rest Stop*, a short film that was funded by the New Zealand Film Commission. It went on to be nominated for Best Script at the New Zealand Film Awards and screened at the Palm Springs International Film Festival in the same year.

Jochen's career sees him at work in both television and film productions. More recently has worked as a VFX Editor on Columbia Pictures *30 Days of Night* and an editor on Disney's long-running series, *Power Rangers*.

# **Director's Notes**

Of all the films I've written, *Bridge* is the script that excited me to a degree that inspired me to return to my first passion: the director's chair. Why the excitement? First and foremost, this script exemplifies a style and genre that I have a passion for; fantasy and thriller. This is something that I have studied and adored, and as a film maker it's worked for me. With *Bridge*, I wanted to challenge myself as a storyteller by being faithful to the genres but also have a go at pushing them to their limits so not to be pigeon-holed within a style or tone.

With a high concept, my challenge was to then root the story and characters in something common but most importantly human. The idea of the bond between two people in a relationship worked well with what I saw as happening in this story both thematically and tonally. Using the concept of the gravitational "laws of attraction" I used the same phrase with the ideas of a struggling relationship between two lovers. I question not only what is it that draws us to a person but what is it that draws us to that person even after the relationship has ended?

With the combination of stunts and computer generated images, I believe we have put together a strong visual film unlike anything else in it's field. I am proud and happy to present to you a love story like no other.

# **Producer's Bio**

#### Zane Holmes



For the last nine years Zane has been on the forefront of television and film drama production in New Zealand. Initially working in post-production Zane took a position *on The Lord of the Rings* before moving onto produce and direct television in Auckland. Some of these shows include BBC's *Maddigans Quest* and Emmy-nominated *Being Eve*.

More recently Zane has acted as a post-supervisor for feature films and drama series, a technical and creative consultant for local production companies, and a lecturer at Universities and film schools in Auckland. Zane currently lives in Auckland, New Zealand, and is developing feature films through his production company, *Collective Vision*, with Vanessa Alexander. He prefers the label chronologically challenged instead of workaholic insomniac.

#### Ashley Stuart Coupland



Orginally from Scotland Ashley has worked in film and television for eleven years. She started out as an art director working on commercials and music videos in London before moving into production and drama. She currently works is an Executive Producer for a television company in Auckland.

Her last two NZFC short films *Tiga e le iloa* and *break* have screened at festivals around the world including Sundance, Montreal, and New York; with *break* screening 'in competition' at the 2006 Clermont-Ferrand International Film Festival, and winning the 2006 Jury Prize at the 35<sup>th</sup> American Dance on camera Awards.

# **Production Company – Collective Vision**

*Collective Vision* began seeking projects for development in October of 2005. Since then Zane Holmes and Vanessa Alexander have produced two projects under the *Collective Vision* banner; Shorts Films *Cargo* and *Bridge* – together Vanessa and Zane have a long history of collaboration – and an impressive set of producing, writing and directing credits in the New Zealand Film and Television industry. Many of their credits as producer are for well-known production houses like South Pacific Pictures, Greenstone, and Screentime. Other credits are for smaller independent sole-purpose companies, and government development organizations like the New Zealand Film Commission.

With Zane beginning life in the film industry as an editor, and Vanessa commencing as a writer, the formation of *Collective Vision* seemed the perfect way to bring together the two ends of production. While both Vanessa and Zane have enjoyed their work with other productions companies (and seek to maintain

some of these ties) they want to develop projects of their own. With Vanessa's background in writing and script development married with Zane's up-to-theminute technical expertise, we expect *Collective Vision* to be greater than the sum of it's parts.

*Collective Vision* aims to achieve as a company the sort of international reputation and success that Zane and Vanessa have enjoyed on the many projects they have acted on as producers, for other production houses, over the last seven years.

#### \*Awards\*

Collectively, Zane and Vanessa have produced projects that have been nominated for an International Emmy and an Academy Award; they have also won between them:

Best Drama Series NZTV Awards, Best Kids Series NZTV Awards, a Qantas Media Award, a Telly Award, a Gold and Silver Medal at the NY Festivals, the Grand Prix at the Danube Television Festival, Best Contribution to Design, Young Filmmaker of the Year, and the World Drama Trust International Student Playwriting Competition.

## **Director of Photography**

Rob Marsh has been in the film industry for over twenty years and has extensive experience on feature and short films, television commercials, and television drama in New Zealand and abroad. These include camera operating on *The Lord of The Rings*, *The Chronicles of Narnia*, and *30 Days of Night*. Rob also has a list of short film credits including Sean Astin's *The Long and the Short of It* made during production of *The Lord of the Rings*. In his spare time Rob enjoys travelling around various beaches in New Zealand and helps look after his three young children.

## Music

The Nutrients are Wellington-based musicians Lucaz Pawel Buda and Thomas Conrad Wedde. Also members of *The Phoenix Foundation* who signed to *Young American Recordings* and did the soundtrack for last years independent hit, *Eagle Vs Shark*, Luke and Conrad still find time to work on their own projects including Luke's solo album released in 2006, *Special Surprise*.
