WRITER / DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY - LUKE SAVAGE

Luke Savage is an Auckland based director having studied film in New Zealand and France. He has directed numerous award winning TV commercials and music videos.

With a background in visual effects, animation and comedy direction, Monifa marks a distinct new direction in Luke's filmmaking.

DIRECTORS' NOTES

The heart of the film is Monifa and her emotional journey - through her experiences we gain a new perspective on what it means to live in New Zealand. The story explores fear, depression, grief, trust, acceptance, friendship, race, family and healing - all from a very subjective viewpoint.

In the film Monifa must choose whether to let others into her heart and begin to trust again. This to me is the core of Monifa's journey and the aspect we chose to focus on in the script and execution of the film.

Monifa doesn't speak a single line in the film - often others put words into her mouth, so it was important that her emotional journey could be evoked both visually and with sound. For Monifa the boundaries between reality and imagination are often blurred and this allowed us a wonderful freedom in terms of using evocative images and haunting soundscapes to bring the audience into Monifa's mindset.

PRODUCER'S BIOGRAPHY - ANNA STUART

Anna entered the film industry in 2001 starting with Music Videos in Auckland quickly gaining herself a role as Associate Producer on the New Zealand / Canadian Feature Film Nemesis Game in 2002.

Solidifying her passion for production Anna became involved with a local production company producing music videos and commercials, where she teamed up with Luke Savage.

Having produced for Luke for a number of years, it was a natural progression to move into making short films together. Monifa is the first short film Anna has produced and is currently working on funding for another two scripts.
