WRITER AND DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY:

In 2002 Nigel McCulloch, Ryan Hutchings and Jarrod Holt started thedownlowconcept on a small farm in Matakana. From here they developed radio shows for National Radio in New Zealand, including the news quiz 'Off the Wire' which they wrote and produced 120 episodes of over 3 years, and which won the NZ comedy guild "Best Radio Show" award.

In 2006 the thedownlowconcept entered the 48-hour film competition for the first time with their entry 'Brown Peril: The Tim Porch Story'. The short-film struck a chord with audiences and judges alike and went on to become the Grand National Winner, as well as the overall script award. The film was later entered in the Richmond short film festival where it won four major awards. They also competed in 2007 and 2008, making the finals every year and coming runner up in 2008. They won the Auckland 48 Hour Final and were crowned National Champions again in 2010 for their film 'Only Son'. The film also won best script and best short at the Qantas Film and TV awards.

Their efforts with short film have not been in vain and the boys are now hard at work on their debut feature film 'Tuvalu', based on the adventures of the last man left on the first island to sink under rising ocean levels. They also have numerous comedy series in development in the UK, including one with Ash Atalla (producer of The Office and The IT Crowd) and another with Steve Coogan and his production company Baby Cow. As well as the feature film and scripted comedy the boys are working on their radio shows and writing/producing on their panel show comedy series 7Days and in pre-production on their first scripted comedy series 'Hounds' - based around the world of greyhounds.
