

APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE: CO-PRODUCTION OR CERTIFICATION

This application form can be used for either provisional approval of a production as an official co-production or provisional certification of a production as a New Zealand film for tax purposes. If you are applying for certification as a New Zealand film, then you do not need to complete the parts of this application form which relate to the foreign co-producer.

<u>Note</u>: Expenditure on New Zealand elements for the purposes of a co-production is unlikely to be the same as qualifying New Zealand production expenditure for the purposes of the New Zealand Screen Production Rebate (NZSPR). For example; costs relating to the services of New Zealanders performed overseas during pre-production do not count as New Zealand production expenditure for the purposes of NZSPR but do count as New Zealand expenditure for the purpose of coproduction.
