





10 APRIL 2024: OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND PRIVACY ACT REQUESTS

I refer to your letter dated 10 April 2024 which, among other things, requested information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) and the Privacy Act 2020 (to the extent the requested information is your client's personal information). You have requested:

- a) All documents relating to applications for funding from the NZ Film Commission including the NZSP Rebate for the Ardern documentary, including all documents provided in support of the applications and all documents relating to the Commission's decision-making on these applications (first request).
- b) All documents relating to the Commission's response to [your client's] email of 12 March 2024 headed "Public Funding" and to the subsequent correspondence between [your client] and Ms Murray, including without limitation:
 - (i) Communications between the Commission and [the named person] (second request).
 - (ii) Documents relating to the dissemination of [your client's] emails or their contents to any other person either within or outside the Commission (third request).
 - (iii) Documents relating to steps taken by the Commission to investigate the matters raised by [your client] in [their] emails (fourth request).

FIRST REQUEST: FUNDING (EQUITY AND REBATE)

Equity funding

As publicly announced NZFC approved Feature Film Production Investment (FFPI) of \$800,000 to *The Untitled PBK and JP Project* (formerly referred to as *Jacindamania*). Your client will be familiar with this type of FFPI equity investment and the basis on which NZFC may recoup its investment.

Information you have requested in relation to this FFPI funding decision is attached at Appendix 1. Certain commercially sensitive and personal information has been redacted under the following grounds of the OIA:

- Section 9(2)(a): to protect the privacy of natural persons.
- Section 9(2)(b)(ii): to protect information where the making available of that information would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.
- Section 9(2)(ba): to protect information that is the subject to an obligation of confidence where making the information available would be likely to prejudice the supply of similar information and it is in the public interest that such information should continue to be supplied.
- Section 9(2)(g): to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions.
- Section 9(2)(h): to maintain legal privilege.

Other information that is not within the scope of your request has also been redacted.

The record of a pre-application meeting, full budget, assessor's reports, estimates of financial success, distribution and marketing deals are withheld in their entirety under subsections 9(2)(b)(ii), 9(2)(ba), and 9(2)(g) of the OIA.

NZFC anticipates that the withholding of this commercially sensitive information will not surprise your client, who would likely object to NZFC releasing under the OIA similar information supplied to it by them (or one of their associated entities) in support of any applications by them for Rebate or equity funding.

New Zealand Screen Production Rebate Funding

New Zealand Screen Production Rebate is available only where a production meets the NZSPR qualifying criteria and a NZSPR Final Certificate has been applied for and granted. As your client will be aware, an application for a Final Certificate can only be made after a production has been completed. In other words, all NZFC Rebate funding decisions occur after production is completed.

No application for a NZSPR Final Certificate for *Untitled PBK and JP Project* has been received by NZFC. Your request for this category of information is refused under s 18(e) of the OIA (that the requested information does not exist).

SECOND REQUEST: COMMUNICATIONS WITH NAMED PERSON RELATING TO 'PUBLIC FUNDING' EMAIL

Information you have requested in relation to communications with the named person relating to your client's 12 March 2024 email is attached as **Appendix 2**.

Certain commercially sensitive information has been redacted under the following grounds of the OIA:

- Section 9(2)(b)(ii): to protect information where the making available of that information would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.
- Section 9(2)(ba): to protect information that is the subject to an obligation of confidence where making the information available would be likely to prejudice the

supply of similar information and it is in the public interest that such information should continue to be supplied.

THIRD REQUEST: DISSEMINATION OF 12 MARCH 2024 'PUBLIC FUNDING' EMAIL

Documents relating to this aspect of your request are my email of 13 March 2024 to the specified person included in Appendix 2 (and previously provided to your client on 26 March 2024) and the further documents included in **Appendix 3**.

Redactions have been made for information that is outside the scope of your client's request and under:

- Section 9(2)(b)(ii): to protect information where the making available of that
 information would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of
 the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.
- Section 9(2)(ba): to protect information that is the subject to an obligation of confidence where making the information available would be likely to prejudice the supply of similar information and it is in the public interest that such information should continue to be supplied.
- Section 9(2)(g): to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions.
- Section 9(2)(h): to maintain legal professional privilege.

FOURTH REQUEST: INVESTIGATIVE STEPS

In order to investigate the serious allegations made by your client, it was necessary to assess commercially sensitive information relating to relevant productions. To avoid having to refuse your client's request in its entirety (by withholding all such commercially sensitive information that was inherent in the investigation) I am providing a summary of steps taken in accordance with s 16(1)(e) of the OIA.

As a first step, I provided the named person with a natural justice opportunity to comment on the allegations made against them. I received a substantive response from them on 20 March 2024 in which they rejected the allegations (and other perceived inaccuracies in your client's email). Their response has been included in Appendix 2.

In relation to the allegation of [REDACTED], my staff were asked to investigate. In relation to the [REDACTED], [REDACTED] provided the Cost Report, Trial Balance, General Ledger, List of Creditors and the Aged Payables List. In addition, copies of bank statements were requested and promptly provided. My staff were able to reconcile the accounting reports with the bank statements and verified the transactions. Based on those records, there was no evidence that supported your client's allegation [REDACTED].

In relation to the allegation [REDACTED], I commissioned a further independent review of the financials and budget for the relevant production. The reviewer was given access to all the commercially sensitive budget and financial information held by NZFC relating to the relevant production. That independent review did not identify any basis for me to conclude that your client's [REDACTED] allegation had substance.

Overall there is no evidence available to me to suggest that the allegations made by your client in their 12 March 2024 email are likely to be able to be substantiated and/or warrants NZFC resources being deployed to investigate further.

We will be publishing this letter (with content referring to the substance of your client's allegations and your client's personal information removed) with Appendix 1 on the NZFC website. Appendices 2 and 3 will not be made publicly available on the website, for obvious legal reasons arising out of the need to avoid further dissemination or republication of your client's potentially defamatory allegations.

As you will be aware, your client has the right, by way of complaint to the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the OIA to seek an investigation and review of NZFC's response and to make a complaint to the Privacy Commissioner in respect of NZFC's responses relating to their personal information request.






