- 4. Please provide all information relating to per diems (or similar) that were paid to those attending by the film commission.*
- 5. Please provide a copy of the diaries and all meetings/functions/engagements/parties/afterparties attending by film commission staff while overseas the OSCARS and the same for anyone attending with funding from the Commission. Please outline any studio producers, directors, filmmakers etc that any of the aforementioned people met with.*

The New Zealand Film Commission (NZFC) did not send any delegations to the 2024 Oscars or fund any individuals or organisations to attend.
